# Prior Activities of Sustainability Working Group

- Survey of AgBioData membership regarding sustainability (2022)
- Identification of possible exemplar resources (2023)
- Invitation of selected resources for further sustainability modeling (2023)

## Current Activities of Sustainability Working Group

- Interviews with 7 principal investigators for AgBioData resources
- Interview format: semi-structured interview to explore perceived strengths, challenges, and opportunities for the future of their resources
- Results will be documented for each PI summarizing the conversation with them with a request for them to edit/comment and provide more data/information as needed at their discretion.

### Current Activities of Sustainability Working Group (cont.)

#### **Continuing Work**

- Review completed interview transcripts and send to the PI's
- Schedule remaining resource PI interviews in mid-May
- Complete analysis and synthesis across interviews
  Share draft report with the SWG for review by the end of May

#### **Preliminary themes**

- Without sufficient funding- prioritization of what is done, loss of knowledge when staff leave
- Organizational constraints to competitive salaries, time it takes to hire, and flat funds
- Excitement around the opportunities for databases (with sufficient funding)
- Supportive of being part of AgBioData
